- 1. Educational qualification: Graduation and above from a recognised university.
- 2. Age Limits: (1) A candidate must have attained the age of 21 years and maximum age of 32 years. (2) The upper age-limit prescribed above will be relaxable: (a) up to a maximum of five years if a candidate belongs to a Scheduled Caste or a Scheduled Tribe; (b) up to a maximum of three years in the case of candidates belonging to Other Backward Classes who are eligible to avail of reservation applicable to such candidates; (c) up to a maximum of three years in the case of Defence Services Personnel, disabled in operations during hostilities with any foreign country or in a disturbed area and released as a consequence thereof;

- Mode of selection will be strictly based on the merit obtained in the screening test. The screening test will comprise of 100 multiple choice question from General Studies and each question shall have 2 marks.



1. Centre for Coaching and Career Planning

The Centre for Coaching and Career Planning was established in March, 2021 under the aegis of University of Ladakh, Kargil Campus and Supported by Central Waqf Council – Ministry of Minority Affairs, Govt. of India.

The main thrust of the Coaching Programme is to prepare candidates from the Minority Muslim community of UT Ladakh to compete and secure jobs in Government and Public Sector Units. Academic support and guidance along with personality development interventions are emphasized at the Centre for holistic development of candidates to face the stiff competition for entry into various services.

2. Infrastructure and Facilities

The Centre is located in the Kargil campus of University of Ladakh, Kargil. Necessary infrastructures such as class rooms, library, offices etc. are properly available to cater to the requirements.

Academic Activities

The contextual and required lectures and interactive sessions will be conducted by qualified and competent resource persons, drawn from respective fields and expertise. The coaching program, spread over a period of 10 months, is rigorous and intensive. Regular written Tests are conducted to evaluate the performances of the Candidates.

In addition, personality development of the candidates is emphasized by personal support and guidance. Regular interactive sessions with successful Civil Servants are also being conducted for the candidates. Group discussions and debates among candidates are encouraged to develop communication skills.

Library
